Statement of Policy and Terms

This offer is made solely on the terms and conditions stated in the Statement of Policy and Terms and no others.

Buyers acceptance of this Statement of Policy and Terms is limited to the terms and conditions of this Statement of Policy and Terms. Any additional or different terms or conditions proposed by Buyer shall not become a part of this Statement of Policy and Terms. Seller hereby objects to any proposed changes.

In the event of any inconsistency between the terms and conditions of this Statement of Policy and Terms and the provisions of any purchase order or other document submitted by Buyer, the terms and conditions of this Statement of Policy and Terms shall control.

Non-Reworkable Hardware: Quotes made by Safe Plating, Inc. take into account the liability of only the plating processing, non-precious metals, and precious metals*. Therefore, Safe Plating, Inc. is only to be liable to whichever is lesser of 1 times the cost of processing with non-precious metals, 1 times the cost of processing with precious metals with plated material being returned to Safe Plating, Inc., or the unprocessed direct cost of the unplated material. For orders that require a minimum charge, Safe Plating, Inc. is liable for 1 times the minimum charge. Liability that is in excess of this policy must be agreed upon prior to processing in which Safe Plating, Inc. reserves the right to re-quote the order to cover the added liability.

Rejected Material: Safe Plating, Inc, requires notice on any order that is rejected or potentially rejected within 15 days. Samples of rejected material must be returned to Safe Plating, Inc. for verification. If parts are found to be out of the acceptable range, material is to be returned to Safe Plating, Inc. for rework. If material is found to be non-reworkable, our liability above applies. If parts are found to be acceptable, material is to be returned to customer for evaluation.

Count Discrepancy: Due to the may varying methods of counting loose plated material, Safe Plating, Inc. maintains a 2% variance in count. If Safe Plating, Inc. incoming count exceeds 2% on either side, Safe Plating, Inc. will notify the customer. If you the customer finds a count discrepancy that exceeds 2%, Safe Plating, Inc. requires notice within 15 days. For continuous reel-to-reel plated material, the 2% count variance only applies to those orders that meet the MOQ of the specific part number. Those orders that do not meet the MOQ, are to be negotiated.

Best Effort Basis: When stated, best effort basis mean material that is processed and shipped by Safe Plating, Inc. may contain parts that would be deemed unacceptable by nature. These orders will be quoted and negotiated as such. Material and orders that fall under this umbrella are deemed non-rejectable, and Safe Plating holds no liability.

By signing and returning this Statement of Policy and Terms to Safe Plating, Inc. you agree to all statements listed within this document. Any changes or terms agreed to that fall outside of this Statement of Policy and Terms must be attached via and addendum and signed and agreed upon by all parties.
